Sub: Amendment/Addition in Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board-reg.

Sir/Madam,

Consequent upon recommendations of the Affiliation Committee made in its meetings held on 26.3.2013 and 24.6.2013 and subsequently approval of the Governing Body of the Board in its meeting held on 28.6.2013, the following amendments/additions in Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board have been made by the Board:-

S.No	Existing Rule and Provisions	Amended Rule
1.	Addition	Added under Chapter-IV Rule 19.1 (ii) (a): "Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee".
II B	Rule 7. 2 No part of income from the institution shall be diverted to any individual in the frust/Society/ Company egistered under section 25 of the companies act, 1956 School Management Committee or to any other person. The savings, if any, ofter meeting the recurring ind non-recurring expenditure and contributions	Rule 7. 2 No part of income from the institution shall be diverted to any individual in the Trust/Society/ Company registered under section 25 of the companies act, 1956 School Management Committee or to any other person. The savings, if any, after meeting the recurring and non-recurring expenditure and contributions to developmental, depreciation and contingency funds may be further utilized for promoting the school. The school seeking provisional affiliation with the Board must have formal prior recognition of the State/U.T. Govt. Its application either should be forwarded by the State Govt. or there should be a No Objection Certificate to the effect that State Government has no objection to the affiliation of the school with the CBSE. "No Objection Certificate" once issued to any school will be considered at par even if it s prescribes a specific period of "stage"

Rule 3.3 (I) chapter II

The school seeking provisional affiliation with the Board must have formal prior recognition of the State/U.T Govt. and also to produce evidence to this effect that the applicant school had intimated to the concerned Education Department of the State about the application made to CBSE for seeking affiliation with the Board. In case, the Board receives any objection during the process application of the school, the Board may ask the concerned school to produce the No Objection Certificate from the State Government or otherwise it would be that assumed concerned State/U.T. Government has No objection.

No Objection Certificate issued by the State/U.T Government to/schools other than CBSE would be considered by the Board at par with the NOC that issued for seeking Affiliation with the CBSE.

Besides above the Board has also approved that the schools offering vocational courses can suffix "CBSE next generation school" with its name. If the school wishes to use the suffix, it will inform the Board in advance.
